1 Introduction and purpose

Background

"Blind Massage Therapists enjoy a privilege to serve therapy clients that might otherwise be denied. However, sometimes the most vulnerable members (especially students) in our field, whom we frequently recruit for our programs, are inexperienced or have previous failed attempts."
